Theme Press Default Site Theme

Prompt

The [theme](#) automatically used for new spaces, until overridden.

Definition

When a new space is created, Theme Press automatically applies a chosen theme to that space. Additionally, this Default Site Theme is used for all Confluence admin pages, such as the user profile page, and is automatically applied to the [Theme Press Default space](#).

[Vanilla](#), a built-in theme, is automatically set as the Default Site Theme when Theme Press is installed*. (You can [override this at any time](#) within space settings.)

If the Theme Press Default Site Theme is changed:

- all spaces using the default will change to the new theme.
- newly created spaces will also use the new default.
- spaces that have overridden the default site theme will not be changed.

*Previous to version 3.0, the built-in theme was [Lumen](#).
