## Prompt

Apply a Page Status to a page that isn't in a Content Flow workflow.

## Outcome

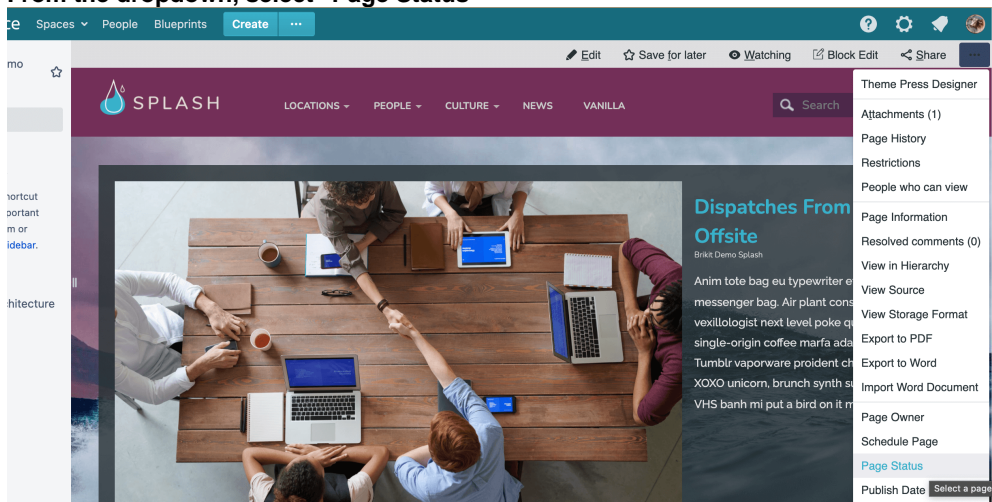
Assign a [Page Status](#) to a Confluence page.

## Steps

Open the [Confluence Page Tools Menu](#) and click "Space Tools"

You must be a [space](#) or [system administrator](#) to perform this action. If using Brikit Theme Press as well, [toggle open the Confluence menus](#) to access the Sidebar.

**From the dropdown, select "Page Status"**



**Select the page status from the dropdown**
