
Topmost portion of the [page canvas](#) header area.

Definition

The Brikit Theme Press header is the area that spans across the top of the page canvas, directly below the [Confluence Page Tools Menu](#).

It is managed by a header [architect page](#) and occupies the top portion of the [header layer](#) in a theme.

This header can be used to hold graphics, text, or links. It can also be empty (`.brikit.header.Empty`).



Info



The Theme Press Header is not the same thing as the [Confluence Header](#).

- This header is a Theme Press architectural component that you can design and apply to selected pages or [spaces](#).
- The Confluence Header is a site-wide header that provides access to Confluence tools and features.
