The Confluence Header is the menu area that spans across the top of a Confluence page.



This menu allows users to:

- Navigate to the site home page
- Explore the space directory
- Search via the [Confluence search box](#)
- Access help content
- Log into the site

Authenticated users who have been granted permissions can also:

- Explore the people directory
- Create a new page
- Access the [Confluence Administration menu](#)
- View notifications
- Manage profile settings

- The Confluence Header provides access to Confluence tools and features and spans the entire width of the browser.
- The Theme Press Header is part of a themed page's architecture and is located beneath the [Confluence Page Tools menu](#).
