Theme Press Default Space

Prompt

The space where a site's [architect pages](#) are stored.

Definition

The Theme Press Default Space keeps all of your site's **architect pages** in a space called the Theme Press Default Space. Creating and editing architect pages (**menus, headers, footers, and page layouts**) is done in this space.

The Theme Press Default Space is automatically created when Theme Press is installed.

There are two ways to access this space:

1. Direct URL
