#### Applying a Theme to a Space

#### **Prompt**


Give your space a look and feel unique from the default site theme.

#### Outcome

There may be situation where you'd like a specific space to a have a different theme than the rest of the site. Instead of changing the default site theme, the steps below describe how to apply a theme to just one space.

# **Steps**

- 1. Open the Theme Press Designer by pressing the "." (period, full stop) key.
- 2. Click on the Space Tab. (note: in previous versions, it was called the Architect Tab).
- 3. Expand the Space Theme accordion.
- 4. Click the Use Space Theme button.
- 5. Click the magnifying glass to the right of the Space Theme setting.
- 6. Select a theme from the Available Themes section.
  - The Change Space Theme window opens.
- 7. Click the OK button to confirm the change and wait for the theme to update.
