Definition

In any theme, a palette of pre-defined colors is determined for easy user access, allowing color use to stay true-to-brand. Additionally, these palettes determine how color selection cascades out into overall [theme design](#).

There are three different palette areas:

The Core Palette	The Tints and Shades Palette	The Grays Palette
These are three distinct colors that can be used to identify a space for a company, a department, a product, or a specific activity. - The palette options are displayed directly below the color picker in any color selection context, within the [Theme Press Designer](#).
- Additionally, the palette options are the first options in the Confluence editor color picker.
- Creating these color palettes does not prevent users from choosing other colors.
