# Monitoring Page Rendering Performance

## Prompt

Tracking the time it takes for pages to load.

## Outcome

Enabling this feature allows you to track page performance via performance logging.

## Steps

### Access the hidden Admin UI

Your Confluence Base URL/admin/darkfeatures.action

### Enable the dark feature `com.brikit.themepress.profiling`

Site Dark Features section

### Enable **DEBUG** logging for `com.brikit.themepress.profiling`

Confluence General Configuration Administration Logging and Profiling

TO DISABLE:

1. Access the hidden Admin UI Your Confluence Base URL/admin/darkfeatures.action
2. Click "**remove**" for `com.brikit.themepress.profiling`

## Note



- Requires Confluence Administrator permission
- Enabling **Page Rendering** will create a large number of log entries. **Use only for test environments**, or during low-usage periods in production environments (such as nights or weekends).
