Applying a Theme to a Space

Prompt

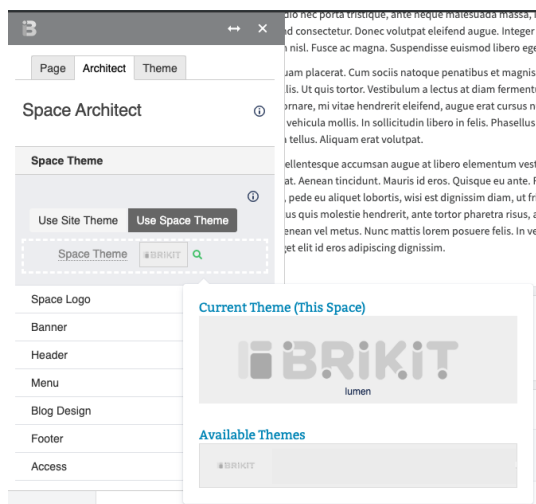
Give your space a look and feel unique from the [default site theme](#).

Outcome

There may be situation where you'd like a specific space to have a different theme than the rest of the site. Instead of [changing the default site theme](#), the steps below describe how to apply a theme to just one space.

Steps

1. Open the [Theme Press Designer](#) by pressing the "." (period, full stop) key.
2. Click on the **Space Tab**. (note: in previous versions, it was called the Architect Tab).
3. Expand the **Space Theme** accordion.
4. Click the **Use Space Theme** button.
5. Click the magnifying glass to the right of the **Space Theme** setting.
6. Select a theme from the **Available Themes** section.
The **Change Space Theme** window opens.
7. Click the **OK** button to confirm the change and wait for the theme to update.
