# Architect Pages

## Prompt

Underlying 'control' pages, which help shape, configure, and contribute content.

## Definition

An architect page is the location of one of the five primary types of site structures listed below — both where the structure resides and where it is managed. When you create a menu, for example, you [create a menu architect page](#).

Each architect page adds structure and content to **page display** across a site. Architect pages can be set to be used across the entire site (a site default), at just the space level, and in some cases, at the individual page level ([page design architect pages](#)). All architect pages reside in the [Theme Press Default Space](#).

| Type                   | Purpose                                                              | Level             |
|------------------------|----------------------------------------------------------------------|-------------------|
| Banner                 | Displays system messages above the <a href="#">Confluence Header</a> | Site, Space       |
| <a href="#">Header</a> | Displays content in the <a href="#">header</a>                       | Site, Space       |
| <a href="#">Menu</a>   | Provides site/space navigation in the <a href="#">header</a>         | Site, Space       |
| <a href="#">Layout</a> | Defines page structure and, potentially, content                     | Site, Space, Page |
| <a href="#">Footer</a> | Displays content in the canvas footer                                | Site, Space       |
