Defining Font Families

Prompt

A first step to working with fonts in your theme.

Outcome

Inserting font family notation in the [Theme Designer](#) allows you to apply these fonts throughout your theme, and use them consistently across page and space design.

Steps

Navigate to the Font area of the [Theme Designer](#).

Theme Press Designer Theme Tab Content Fonts Choices Font Families

Insert naming for each font family, separated by a semicolon.

The font family list is also referred to as a [Font Stack](#).

Format

```
fontFamily1: "<font name 1>", "<font name 2>", "<font name 3>";  
fontFamily2: "<font name 1>", "<font name 2>", "<font name 3>";
```

Example

```
fontFamily1: "Helvetica Neue", Helvetica, Arial, sans-serif;  
fontFamily2: Georgia, Times, "Times New Roman", serif;
```

- Font names with one word do not need quotes.
- You can add additional families as needed.
- Multiple font weights and styles can be referenced under one family name.
