Scheduled Page

Prompt

A page that is subject to having its viewing restrictions automatically changed at a given time.

Definition

Brikit's [Content Flow](#) allows you to set the time frame, also called a [scheduled window](#), during which a page (or blog post) is viewable by all users with view permissions. Setting this scheduled window makes this page a *scheduled page*. A scheduled page means that it will be [released](#) at a [release time](#) and, optionally, [hidden](#) at a [hide time](#).

Scheduled pages are smart ways to release news articles, blog posts, seasonal announcements, or any content in need of a strict period of visibility.
