Prompt

A [reviewer](#)'s option in a [workflow step](#). Clicking 'Return' regresses the workflow to the previous step.

Definition

In a [Content Flow workflow](#), the 'Return' button indicates your disapproval of a draft page's content. Adding a comment along with your 'Return' click helps to convey to [reviewers](#) of the previous step what needs to change before the page should advance again.

Upon disapproval, the workflow returns to the previous [step](#), and [reviewers](#) of both the previous step and the returned step will need to re-[approve](#) for the workflow to continue.
