Transferring Platform Files

Prompt

Uploading and configuring components of your Brikit Platform on a different server.

Outcome

The [Design and Build phases of site design](#) generally take place in a test or development environment (always our recommendation). In order to migrate into production, content and theme exports, as well as product settings, need to be transferred from one server to another.

Steps

SITE MIGRATION

A site designed in [Brikit Theme Press](#) is generally comprised of three parts: a **theme**, one or more **spaces**, and a set of **architect pages**.

(Tip: Hover on the title links below for a description of each. Click through to the underlying glossary pages for more information, as needed.)

If you are performing your own migration, you will first need to download the items below (e.g. theme, spaces, and architect pages), before uploading to your destination server.

(If you are working with Brikit, the first step of downloading will be done for you — our services team will provide zipped files for uploading.)
