# Copying a Space or Page using the Blueprint Menu

## Prompt

A quick and easy way to make an identical copy of a space or page.

## Outcome

In the [Blueprints Menu](#), you have the option to create a copy of the current space or page. This is an easily accessible and fast way to generate a duplicate.

## Steps

### Open the Blueprints Menu

This is located in the [Confluence Header](#). Check out [Accessing the Brikkit Blueprints Menu](#) for detailed instructions.

### Click "Copy Current Space"

Makes a simple copy of the current space without any field substitution. Any existing permissions are retained in the copy. You will be prompted to enter a new name and space key for the space. The copy includes all content from the source space, including page trees, blogs, and attachments.

### Or, click "Copy Current Page"

Makes a simple copy of the current page without any field substitution. You will be prompted to enter a new page title and a parent page under which this copy will go. All existing page restrictions will be included in the copy.

### That's it!

You now have a copy of the space or page.
