# Installing Theme Press

## Prompt

Installing Theme Press through the Universal Plugin Manager

## Steps

### Install Theme Press

- Follow the installation steps on [Installing and Uninstalling Apps](#)
  - (For step 4, type `Theme Press` in the app search box)

### Configure Theme Press

- From the same screen, select **Configure**
- Click the **Install** button
- Wait for the process to complete

### Apply Theme Press site wide or only to specific spaces

- [Change the Confluence Default Theme](#) to apply Theme Press across all spaces
- Select **Default Theme** as the **Current Theme** to only apply Theme Press to specific spaces

## Note



### Good to Know

- [Installation of Atlassian Confluence](#) is a requirement for Theme Press installation
- Check the [Theme Press Releases](#) page for compatibility information and download links



Some users have reported that after installing Comala apps on a site already using Theme Press, any Theme-Press enabled spaces fail to load (a "Page Not Found" message is shown). This is a known error with the way in which Confluence loads the order of these two apps.

The workaround is simply to *uninstall and then reinstall Theme Press*.
