## Steps

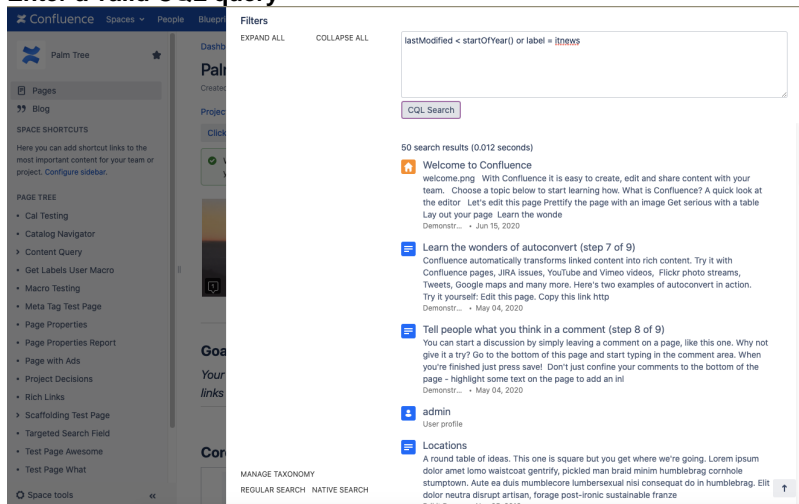
### Open the Search Panel

Clicking a [Targeted Search Field Macro](#) and [Targeted Search Link Macro](#) will open the [Search Panel](#) .

### Click "CQL Search"

Click this link in the lower-left corner of the search panel to toggle the CQL search feature.

### Enter a valid CQL query
