A slide-in, full-length pane for searching and filtering content.

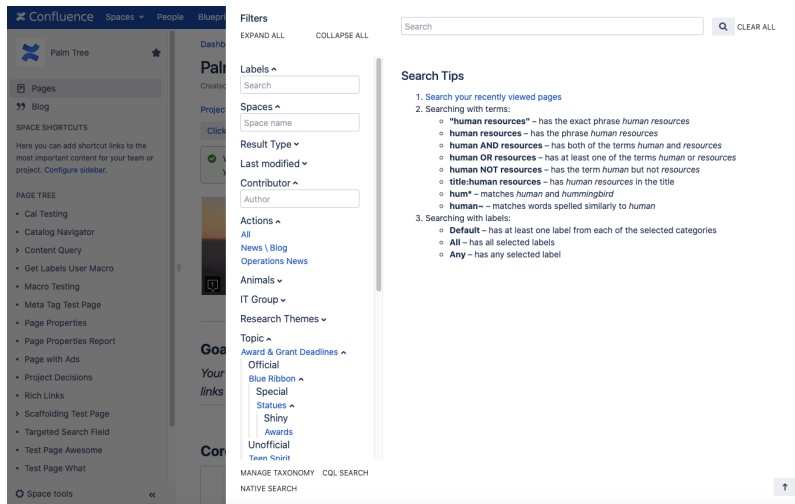
Definition

The search panel is an interactive, advanced-search area that appears at the side of your screen upon clicking the inputs in the [Targeted Search Field Macro](#) and [Targeted Search Link Macro](#). Within the search panel you can search for content by typing in a query, or select from your [filter groups](#) and [filters](#) to retrieve tagged content.

The search panel is also where [advanced users can conduct CQL searches](#) or execute the search in Confluence's native search interface.

Features:

- full-text search
- search & filter by Confluence label, space, content type, last-modified date, and contributor
- search & filter by Targeted Search filter groups and filters
- CQL search
- [Rich Link](#) result previews (for [Theme Press](#) users only)
- Quick access to [taxonomy management](#)
- Built-in and customized Search Tips
- Quick access to recently viewed pages
