# Applying and Removing Cascaded Filters

## Prompt


Right-click a filter to apply it to the current page and all of its children.

## Outcome

[Cascaded filters](#) make it easy to apply filters to an entire sub-tree of pages. Learn how to apply or remove a cascaded filter.

## Steps

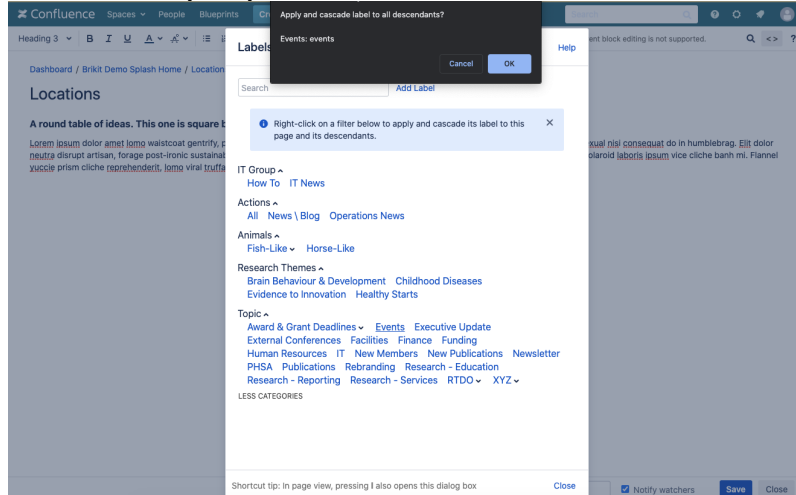
### Toggle the [label application window](#)

You can do this by editing a page or [block](#) and clicking on the label icon  at the top of the editing window.

### Right-click on any filter

By right-clicking, you are applying the cascading label to the current page and its children. There will also be a message in blue describing this action.

### Click OK to the prompt, then "Close" the window



### To remove a label, navigate to the parent page

You may only remove a cascaded label on the parent page.

### Toggle the label application window

### Click the "x" on the pink cascaded filter

All cascaded filters are indicated by their pink background color.

### Click "Close"
