# Page Owner

## Prompt

Brikkit Content Flow allows you to designate a person responsible for the page.

## Definition

In out-of-the-box Confluence, a username is associated with page creation and page modification. But in the real business world, content often requires a third role: that of page owner. The page owner is a special association between a page's content and a Confluence user. It may mean that the user is "responsible for" the content, or is the author of the content (even if not technically the creator or modifier of the *page*).

Additionally, if you are using [workflows](#) to separate content's creation and review from its ownership, this page owner designation can be a more meaningful way to accomplish your publishing goals.

The designation is best used with the [Page Metadata Macro](#), where you can display the name of the owner on the page.
